

## Regional Lawn Care Program

As always, Scotts strives to provide the best possible service to our consumers. This is the suggested Turf Builder lawn care program recommended for your St. Augustine lawn in Texas. Your lawn will be stronger, healthier and more resistant to drought, insects and diseases with this program than a lawn that receives only 2 or 3 applications each year.

### ***TURF BUILDER PROGRAM***

Scotts Bonus® S Southern Weed & Feed *	Mid-March – April
Scotts® Southern Turf Builder® Lawn Fertilizer with 2% Iron	May
Scotts GrubEx	June 10 – August 15
Scotts® Turf Builder® with SummerGuard® **	Mid-June – July
Scotts® Turf Builder® with SummerGuard®	July – August
Scotts Bonus® S Southern Weed & Feed	September
Scotts® Turf Builder® Winterguard Fall Lawn Fertilizer	November

If you are beginning a lawn from plugs or sod, you can use Scotts Bonus® S Southern Weed & Feed at the same time.

\* If weeds are not a problem you can substitute the Scotts Bonus® S Southern Weed & Feed application with Scotts® Southern Turf Builder® Lawn Fertilizer with 2% Iron. A few weeds in the lawn can be controlled with a spot treatment. You may want to consider using Ortho Weed B Gon Max for Southern Lawns. If there are a lot of weeds, a broadcast product, such as Scotts Bonus® S Southern Weed & Feed would be the best choice.

If the St. Augustine grass in your lawn is Floratam, the only product recommendation I can make is using Roundup Weed & Grass Killer for the weeds actively growing in your lawn. Since this product is a non-selective weed control product, spray only the center of each weed; spray lightly until the center just mists. Keep as much product as possible off surrounding lawn grasses.

\*\* If insects are not a problem in your lawn, you can substitute the Scotts® Turf Builder® with SummerGuard® application with Scotts® Southern Turf Builder® Lawn Fertilizer with 2% Iron. A few insects in the lawn can be controlled by spot treating with a product such as Ortho MAX Bug B Gon Conc/Ortho Bug B Gon RTS. If insects are damaging the lawn, a broadcast treatment of Scotts® Turf Builder® with SummerGuard® would be beneficial.
